How do I do a Manual Data-feed in N-link?

Click on 'Utilities'

Then 'Navigator or Protection Datafeeds'


Search for the client/s by typing in their name in the field and then click on find or select the **tick all box** if you are wanting the data-feed for all clients


Once you have the selected clients, click on '**Export**'


Select the time period that you would like the data feed for

Then choose the software provider you want – in this case its 'BGL simple file'

As you can see, there are other options if you would like to create data for other software providers like X-plan or Coin and once you have the data files you will be able to import the files into their software








Note: If you choose nine or less clients – N-link will send a file to an output directory of your choosing – the default output folder is


C:/Apps/LinksSuite/c ache/nav/export

In this situation, you can track the progress as N-link is downloading the data into the Output Directory



When you only have nine or less accounts, once the data-feed is complete, a message similar to this will appear and you can then navigate to where the data is – no email is sent as downloads for 9 or less files is not expected to take very long




While the data-feed is downloading, you can check on the progress by going into 'My Recent Data Feeds' and click 'refresh' to see how far along the Datafeed is –

The limit for download manually is around 500 accounts – so if you have more than this; you may need to split up the manual feeds

Once its complete it will build the file that its going to place in the directory and when its ready to download the data it will show the status as complete




Then the Import data window will come.

Ensure you have the entire spread-sheet selected so you can bring in the data properly as per the screenshot by clicking the box in the top left hand corner above row 1 and next to Column A

Click Ok



And the data will be imported into spreadsheet, formatted for you



Note: The file created maually through N-link can also be imported into your Data-feed software – Below are the formats you can export data in.

If you have a different Software provider, you may have to test which format is compatible. BGL simple file seems to be the most common used and the X-plan format here only creates it in EPI 4.0 format and not 4.2 as per our Automated Data-feeds—so the X-plan format may be a good one to choose as well
